Fee: \$40 per team; \$5 team discount if a CVPC member is on team

Tournament Details:

- 8 teams per division (additional teams may waitlist in event of openings)
- Round Robin Pool Play - two pools per division
- All games to 11, win by 2; except Gold medal play-off match best 2/3 games
- Top 2 teams in each pool advance to single elimination play-off
- Awards provided for 1st-3rd place
- Ball: Franklin X and/or Dura 40
- Pool winners determined by:
 - Win/loss record of Matches
 - Win/Loss record of Games
 - If tie, glory goes to the defense – least points allowed overall
